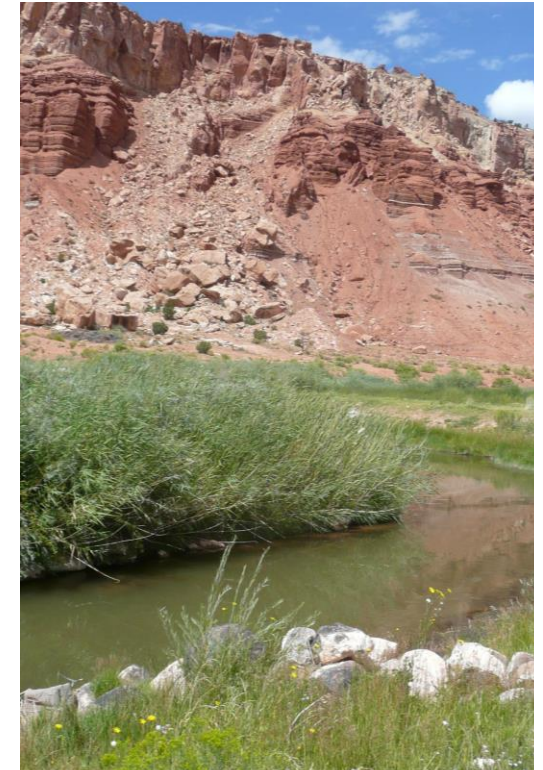
Conservation Tree Program 2016
